Schedule of your Adventure

Show-up 30 minutes before start

1^{frs} to 30th minutes: Safety Briefing

30th to 90^e minute Dogs sled ride

90 tth to 120 ith minutes : Guided tour at the Canine Village

After: Water, Hot coco, Coffee.

Departure times:

- 9h00, 11h30 and 14h00
- 7 days a week
- From December 15th to March 31frs

Details of your Adventure:

Our base Camp is located at the heart of the installations of Mont-Sainte-Anne Cross-Country Ski Resort, only 50 minutes from Québec, where all services are available (Tons of Fun, Food and Lodging).

Your Adventure begins with a 30 minute safety briefing and training with your guide. You will be introduced to your leader dog in order to quickly build a special bond. Your participants are two per sled; one is the driver, the other one passenger. The uneven numbers will share a sled with the guide.

On the snowy path, your guide will give you advice on the care for the dogs and on the unique aspect of Quebec's Winters. The participants can switch places multiple times in order to get the best out of the adventure.

At the finish line, each individual must congratulate every dog before visiting the Canine Village (our kennel) for 30 minutes with your guides. You will learn a lot about the nordic dog's life and the peoples that passionately care for them

Plan your experience

- Book 2h30 hours for the entire activity
- Show-up 30 minutes before the departure time
- 30 minutes of safety briefing and training;
- 60 minutes of trail time;
- 30 minutes guided visit at the kennel
- Water, coffee, hot chocolate available at the end

Recommended Clothing:

- Dress the same way you'd do for alpine skiing
- Wear boots that cover your ankles
- Winter coats, pants and boots rentals at the start.

Requirements:

- Be 6 years old or more
- Children 6 to 17 must be with an adult on the trail
- Dress appropriately with the weather
- Animals are forbidden
- Be sober, not pregnant and with no special heart condition
- Sign the risks recognition form prior of departure
- Be able to walk 1 kilometer alone
- If you don't meet this last requirement you have to take the VIP Formula.
